The Walls of Discrimination

"In junior high school, the kids teased me until the day I graduated, says Aracella. They said that I was stupid. They treated me like I was not human. People kept tearing me down."

Have you ever been left out of groups, games or parties because of your ethnic background? Your religion? The color of your skin? Your height or weight? Were you too slow or too smart or simply "not cool"?

And what about the opposite? Have you excluded somebody from your lunch table or your circle of friends for some of those reasons? If you deal with differences by excluding others – or worse, by hurting them because they are not like your or your friends – you are guilty of discrimination. Discrimination sometimes comes from our own insecurities, fears or lack of self-esteem. Discrimination hurts the person who is being left out or ridiculed or ignored and the one doing the discrimination, too. That person is unable to enjoy the rich human relationships God wants us to share with all our brothers and sisters.

Once Jesus was asked, "Who is my neighbor?". His response was the story of the Good Samaritan. The Samaritans and the Jewish people disliked and distanced themselves from one another. But in Jesus' story, the Samaritan was the only one who came to the aid of the Jewish man who had been robbed, beaten, and left by the roadside to die. Because he showed mercy, the Samaritan was not an enemy but a neighbor.

Don't be a follower, be a leader. Don't feed into negativity such as putting people down for race, age, disability or nationality.

Dealing with discrimination is everybody's responsibility. Remember, all of us are created in the image and likeness of God. So be a "leader and not a follower" in tearing down the "Walls of Discrimination".
