One day, as St. Francis of Assisi was feeding the birds in his garden, he was met by a townsman. He said to St. Francis, "You are always joyful and happy. How do you do it? St. Francis looked at the man and whispered in his ear, "I have been forgiven by God, and He still loves me. Why should I be sad?"

So many people are always sad . . . because they cannot find their purpose in life. Most people want more. When that is not enough, they want something different. When different is not enough, they want change. Their real problem is that they never get to know the love of God.
