Fortunately, a strong loving couple from North Dakota adopted him.

Shawn had wondered "Why me"? Yet, he says he also asked, "why was I adopted by such wonderful people?" In my mind the answer is God brought me through it all so I could use my experience to help others. He has already started by giving time to youngsters with special needs. Shawn often says, "I invited Jesus into my life, as he helped me make peace with the past.

Everyday people make peace with the past, with themselves, and with others. Through God's grace and your efforts, you can know joy today and hope for tomorrow.
