## The Holy Rosary

One day, many years ago, I decided to make a visit to our Lord. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon and the church was empty except for an elderly lady praying in the first pew.

As I prayed, I thought I heard the elderly lady crying. So, I walked down the aisle, and the closer I got I realized she was sobbing.

I said to her, "Can I help you?" She looked at me with tearful eyes and muttered, "I lost my rosary beads that I have had for over forty years, and I can't find them." As I looked down under the pew, I noticed rosary beads. They were discolored and very old. "Are these yours?" She looked at them and smiled. She kissed them, and said, "I will say a Rosary for you".

She then told me that she has been praying the Rosary every day for the past forty years. Her mother gave this pair to her as a gift, and told her, "Mary, the Mother of God loves those who pray the Rosary."

When I left church and got in my car, I thought to myself . . . those old beat-up rosary beads meant more to that lady than all the money in the world. Imagine, for the past forty years she has rubbed those beads and prayed to Mary, the Mother of God. No wonder, those beads were old and tarnished with love.

On Tuesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. It is a prayer very close to Mary's heart. Each decade is a memory of Jesus and Mary's lives on earth. When you pray the Rosary, you relive their lives, and it gives you peace and happiness.

I have often thought of that elderly lady and I'm sure when she died, she carried those old rosary beads to heaven and gave them to the Mother of God. Pray the rosary – even a decade a day and you will feel love.
