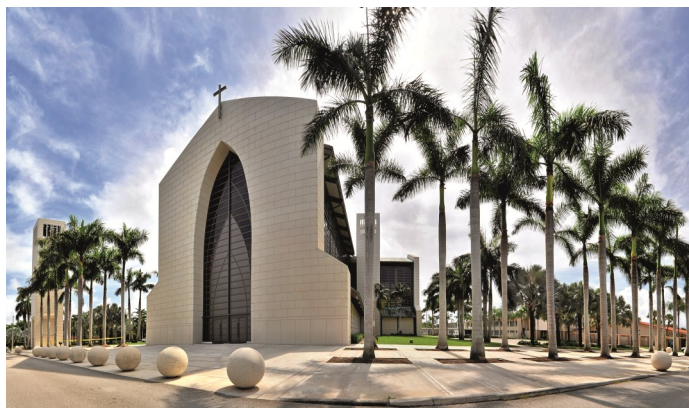

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Maria Wilkes lived in a mountainous area in the Allegheny's. Her husband, John, had recently died and her two sons had left the area to pursue their careers. Occasionally, neighbors would pass by and offer their help knowing that she was all alone. Maria was now 73 years old, and she was afraid to drive and of course this meant not going to church and receiving Holy Communion.

One day a priest came by and introduced himself as Father William, the new Assistant Pastor at their parish church, St. Marks. They had a cup of coffee and Maria told him that she was unable to go to church, and above all receive Holy Communion. He said to her, "Maria, God knows that you cannot drive and knows how much you love Him. He also knows you want to receive Holy Communion, but you are unable. God has provided another way for you to receive Him into your heart. You can receive Him in "Spiritual Communion". This prayer card will help you, just read it and receive our Lord spiritually" . . . After the priest left, Maria read the card.

"Jesus, I believe that You are truly present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist. Every day, I long for more of You. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot receive You sacramentally at this moment, I invite You to come and dwell in my heart. May this Spiritual Communion increase my desire for the Eucharist. You are the healer of my soul. Take the blindness from my eyes, the deafness from my ears, the darkness from my mind, and the hardness from my heart. Fill me with the courage to do your will in all things. My Lord and my God, draw me closer to You, nearer than ever before. Amen."

For those of you unable to receive Communion sacramentally, may this act of Spiritual Communion bring you joy, peace and love. Thank you, Lord.
