St. John Paul 11

On Wednesday October 22nd, we celebrate the Feast of St John Paul II, who reigned as Holy Father from 1978 to 2005. He was born on May 18, 1920, in Wadowice, Poland. He was the first non-Italian Pope in 455 years and the first from a Slavic country. His pontificate of more than 26 years was the third longest in history.

As for his immediate family, his father was a Lieutenant in the Polish Army. His mother Emelia died when he was only 8 years old. Four years after his mother's death, his brother Edmund also died. It is written that in his youth, he was an outgoing young man, very serious and excelled in drama and the theater. He was loved by all of his friends.

In his travels as Pope, John Paul II preached to the whole world his message of religious freedom, national independence and human rights. Pope John Paul II traveled more miles out of Rome than all the popes that preceded him. He was known and respected by all the world's leaders.

There is so much more to his life that would fill volumes. But why was he so effective? Why was he so respected? After reading his encyclicals, I can tell you that the reason he was so successful was that he was holy. He put everything in God's hands and fought for the rights of human beings. He loved people and above all he loved God.

So on Wednesday, pray to St John Paul II and ask him for the courage to stand up for what is right, to love God, do his will and God will always bless you and your family.


