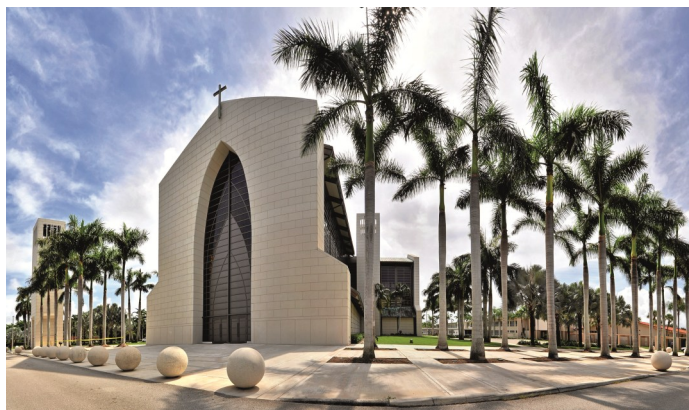

Two Holy Days

This next Saturday and Sunday, we celebrate two very important days in the liturgical life of the church, the Feast of All Saints on November 1st and the Feast of All Souls on November 2nd.

There are thousands of saints, and little is known about many of them. It wasn't until 1171 that the Catholic Church made official the process of canonization of Saints and decreed that only the Holy See has the right to determine sainthood. The Church saw the saints as shining examples for people to pray to and imitate.

All of us know people who live exemplary lives. They are committed and dedicated to their vocation, whether married or single, who share their lives with God. They truly live saintly lives. They are holy not because they do extraordinary deeds, but because they do ordinary deeds in an extraordinary way.

PRE-BAPTISMAL CLASS

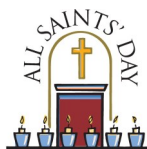
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 15TH, 2025
