He Touched Their Lives

It was 1944. Eleven-year-old Johnny was the second baseman on the St. Francis' Church baseball team in Brooklyn, New York. All the young players were so excited because Father Bonano, the parish priest, had raised enough money to buy the team uniforms.

Father Bonano was a very holy man. He loved his parishioners especially the kids. He worked tirelessly helping the sick, the poor and the troubled. If he wasn't in the Rectory, he was in church praying before the statue of the Blessed Mother. He was deeply loved. He was also the manager of the baseball team.

On Thursday before the big game against St. Bernadette which would determine the championship, Johnny was delivering groceries after school. While he was delivering, he heard someone calling him "Johnny Johnny". He turned around and saw two of his teammates running after him . . ."You will never believe this", his friend said, "Father Bonano has had a heart attack and is in the hospital in critical condition". Johnny stood there stunned. What would they do without their manager? Johnny began to cry.

That night one of the coaches of the team called a meeting in the church hall. The coach consoled the boys and told them Father Bonano would want them to play. After everyone spoke, the team agreed they would play this one for Father Bonano. Before they broke up, they all went into church to pray for Father Bonano before the statue of the Blessed Mother. The Coach ended the visit with the prayer, "Mother of God please hear our prayers."

The championship game was played on Saturday. The stands were packed with parishioners for St. Francis and St. Bernadette. Both teams played their hearts out and St. Francis won 8 to 5. After the game ended, the St. Francis team huddled together and prayed for Father Bonano. There is no doubt that God touched the lives of these boys thanks to Father Bonano. That night Father Bonano died.
