An Invitation to Eternal Life

Today is Palm Sunday. All of us received a palm branch today symbolizing our belief that Jesus is the Son of God. As we processed into Church, we welcomed Jesus into our city knowing that in a few days, we would witness the most tragic and joyous events of our Christian lives.

After the Last Supper, Jesus went with His disciples to the Mount of Olives, and there in a garden, He prayed to His Father. He began to feel dread of the suffering He was about to experience. "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me." So great was His anguish that His sweat became like drops of blood falling down upon the ground. His human heart and will remained steadfastly loyal to the Father. "Nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."

This coming week is Holy Week. It is an invitation for all of us to walk with Jesus as He instituted the Holy Eucharist and ordained His first priests on Holy Thursday. On Good Friday, we will share in His passion and death. Finally, at the Easter Vigil, we will rejoice and witness His resurrection from the dead. Will you be there? Will you walk with Jesus?

Let us put aside all our problems, activities, and concerns; let's plan to spend this week with Christ. Christ died so that we may live and have eternal life. That invitation is open to everyone who does His will. As stewards of the Lord, let's not only accept that invitation, but also let us cling to Christ's saving work and share in the fruits by faith, reception of the sacraments, prayer and works of love.

That's the meaning of Easter, an "Invitation to Eternal Life".
