Carl Maria von Weber - Celebrating 225 years Epiphany Choir and Orchestra Ilian Iliev, clarinet Monday, May 23, 2011, 7:30pm

Considered a transitional composer of the German Romantic, Weber's works for the clarinet are among his most beloved. We will present a performance of his *Clarinet Concerto in F Minor*, with soloist Ilian Iliev, one of the leading clarinetists of his generation. The choir will also sing a rare performance of Weber's beautiful *Mass in Eb*, with soprano Iori Kotake, for the anniversary of this important composer.
